Richard Miller is a longtime member of Holy Family, Miami Gardens, where he has served in a number of leadership roles.

He headed our diocesan deputation to the 2006 General Convention; he has served as a deputy seven times—at every General Convention since 1988--and has been elected to serve for the eighth time in 2009. He is now considered a “senior deputy”. He is currently a member of the national Standing Commission on Ecumenical and Inter-religious Relations, and has previous served as a member of Executive Council, as well as numerous other committees and commissions of The Episcopal Church.

He was recently elected national treasurer of the Union of Black Episcopalians.

He has served the diocese as a member of the Executive Board, and has taken a leadership role on committees and boards dealing with virtually all aspects of diocesan life—for example, budget, communications, Bishop Gray Inn and Episcopal Charities. He is a member of the Cathedral Chapter.

A graduate of Florida Atlantic University, and with a master’s degree from Florida International University, he currently serves as a member of the Cathedral Chapter.
