Tom Huston has been diocesan treasurer since the summer of 1994. It was his careful review of diocesan finances at the beginning of his ministry in this position that led to the discovery of the previously unknown and unallocated \$500,000 that became the impetus for the diocesan planning process in 1996-97, and in recent years has funded the Diocesan Vision Budget.

Tom jokes that retired Bishop Calvin O. Schofield, Jr., promised him that the treasurer's job would involve only "five meetings a year", but in fact, as treasurer he serves not only on the Executive Board, but also on the Budget, Property and Loan and Parish Finance and Assessment Committees. He has also served on the Investment Committee, and the boards of the Southeast Florida Episcopal Foundation (now Episcopal Charities) and the Duncan Center. He has consulted with numerous congregations on property and finance matters.

In his own parish, St. Matthew the Apostle, Miami, Tom has frequently served on the vestry and as a parish officer.

He has served on the Coral Gables Retirement Board for General Employees since 1993, and is a member of the boards of Miami-Dade's Community Partnership for the Homeless, the Salvation Army and the Charlee Homes for abused and neglected children.

In addition to his church and community work, he still runs his own business.

He is a graduate of Duke University and is a veteran of the Air Force, having served as a bomber pilot with the Strategic Air Command during the Cold War.
